Message from Prof. M C Misra



Prof. M C Misra Founder President Indian Hernia Society It is extremely heartening to note that Dr Shambhu Pd Singh and Dr Geeta Prasad accepted a request to organize the 16th, Annual National Conference of the Indian Harnia Society - IHSCON 2025 in February at Ranch, Jharkhand.

Hernia repair has taken centre stage over the last decade, particularly with the advent of Minimally Access techniques coming into vogue. Both groin hernia surgery, as well as ventral/incisional hernia repair, are performed in large numbers by a variety of procedures. There have been recent awakenings about the various techniques for the repair of groin hernia with the standardization of endoscopic repairs. Abdominal wall Reconstruction has also taken centre stage with the focus on component separation with particular attention on posterior component separation, using Transversus Abdominis Release (TAR).

There is also an inclination towards eTEP (Enhanced View) for groin hernia, and the same technique of eTEP helps to learn endoscopic abdominal wall reconstruction using TAR for complex and recurrent incisional and ventral hernias. More and more experience with these techniques is being shared in various live operative workshops and conferences, and additionally, data is being published in current literature.

Groin hernia repair is one of the most common general surgical procedures performed by General Surgeons. Over 700,000 groin hernia repairs are performed each year in the USA alone. The exact number in India is not known, but according to conservative estimates, more than 400,000 repairs are done each year in India. Open hernia repair continues to dominate and is associated with significant morbidity if not performed by properly trained surgeons. Open hernia repair is the first elective operation performed by surgical trainees. To focus on surgical treatment of hernia, Shouldice Technique, Lichtenstein, laparoscopic (TEP & TAPP) repairs, and different techniques of incisional and vitral hernias can be demonstrated and discussed.

Ventral/Incisional hernia repair is the next common hernia performed by a general surgeon. In the USA alone, over 90,000 incisional hernia repairs are done each year. In India, there is no definite data, but more than one lakh, 1,50,000 repairs might be performed according to conservative estimates. Sutured repair is associated with high recurrence rates (as high as 60%). Recurrence rates have significantly come down with prosthetic repair. Lately, Laparoscopic repair of ventral/incisional hernia repair has become the standard of care due to overwhelming advantages in terms of reduced postoperative complications and recurrence. IHSCON 2025 will focus on various aspects of laparoscopic and conventional repair of ventral/incisional hernia.

I welcome you all for active participation during the CME, Conference and live operative workshop on various techniques for inguinal and ventral/incisional hernia repair. There shall be free papers and panel discussions covering various aspects of hernia repair. I am certain that the dynamic team of Jharkhand will put up an absorbing scientific program, a live operative workshop, and wonderful hospitality.

On behalf of the organizing committee, we extend a heartfelt invitation to one and all.

This will be a grand event in Surgical Laparoscopy with the participation of delegates from all over India. We have learned reputed faculty from India are expected to actively participate in this event.

We thank you for your wholehearted support to Team Ranchi for organizing IHSCON 2025.

The conference and Live Operative Workshop will focus on laparoscopic and open repair of inguinal and ventral/incisional hernias.
