Message from Prof. M.C. Misra

It is extremely heartening to note that Dr. Mumtaz A. Ansari (9415301805) and Dr. Vivek Srivastava (9453792147) accepted our request to organise the 15th Annual National Conference of Indian Hernia Society – IHSCON 2023 on 25th and 26th August 2023 at IMS, BHU, Varanasi.

Hernia repair has taken a centre stage over last decade particularly with the advent of Minimally Access techniques coming into vogue. Both groin hernia surgery as well as ventral/ incisional hernia repair are performed in large numbers by variety of procedures. There have been recent awakening about the various techniques for the repair of groin hernia with the standardization of endoscopic repairs. Abdominal wall Reconstruction has also taken a centre stage with the focus on component separation with particular attention on posterior component separation using Transversus Abdominis Release (TAR). There is also inclination towards eTEP (Enhanced View) for groin hernia and the same technique of eTEP helping to learn endoscopic abdominal wall reconstruction using TAR for complex and recurrent incisional and ventral hernias.

More and more experience with these techniques being shared in various live operative workshops and conferences. Additionally, data being published in current literature.

Groin hernia repair is one of the commonest general surgical procedures performed by general surgeons. Over 700,000 groin hernia repairs are performed each year in USA alone. The exact number in India is not known but according to conservative estimate more than 400,000 repairs are done each year in India. Open hernia repair continues to dominate and associated with significant morbidity if not performed by properly trained surgeons. Open hernia repair is the first elective operation performed by surgical trainees. To focus on surgical treatment of hernia; Shouldice Technique, Lichtenstein, laparoscopic (TEP & TAPP) repairs and different techniques of Incisional and ventral hernias will be demonstrated and discussed.

Ventral/incisional hernia repair is the next common hernia performed by general surgeon. In USA alone over 90,000 incisional hernia repair done each year. In India there are no definite data but more then 1,50,000 repairs might be performed according to conservative estimates. Sutured repair is associated with high recurrence rates (As high as 60%). Recurrence rates have significantly come down with the prosthetic repair. Lately laparoscopic repair of ventral/incisional hernia repair has become the standard of care due to overwhelming advantages in terms of reduced postoperative complications and recurrence. IHSCON 2023 will focus on various aspects of laparoscopic and conventional repair of ventral/incisional hernia.

I welcome you all for active participation during the CME, Conference and live operative workshop on various techniques for inguinal and ventral/incisional hernia repair. There shall be free papers and panel discussion covering various aspects of hernia repair. I am certain that the dynamic team lead by Dr. Mumtaz A. Ansari and Dr. Vivek Srivastava and their Team for putting up the absorbing scientific program and live operative workshop and wonderful hospitality.

On behalf of the Organizing Committee, we extend our heartfelt invitation to one and all.

This will be a grand event in Surgical Laparoscopy with participation of delegates from all over India and neighbouring countries. We have learnt reputed faculty from India and overseas are expected to actively participate in this event.

Those of you who would be keen to use the IHSCON 2023 to visit newly opened Kashi – Vishwanath Corridor and darshan, use this opportunity as Laparoscopy Hernia Pilgrimage.
